- Submit your homework sheets in a neatly labeled clear bag.

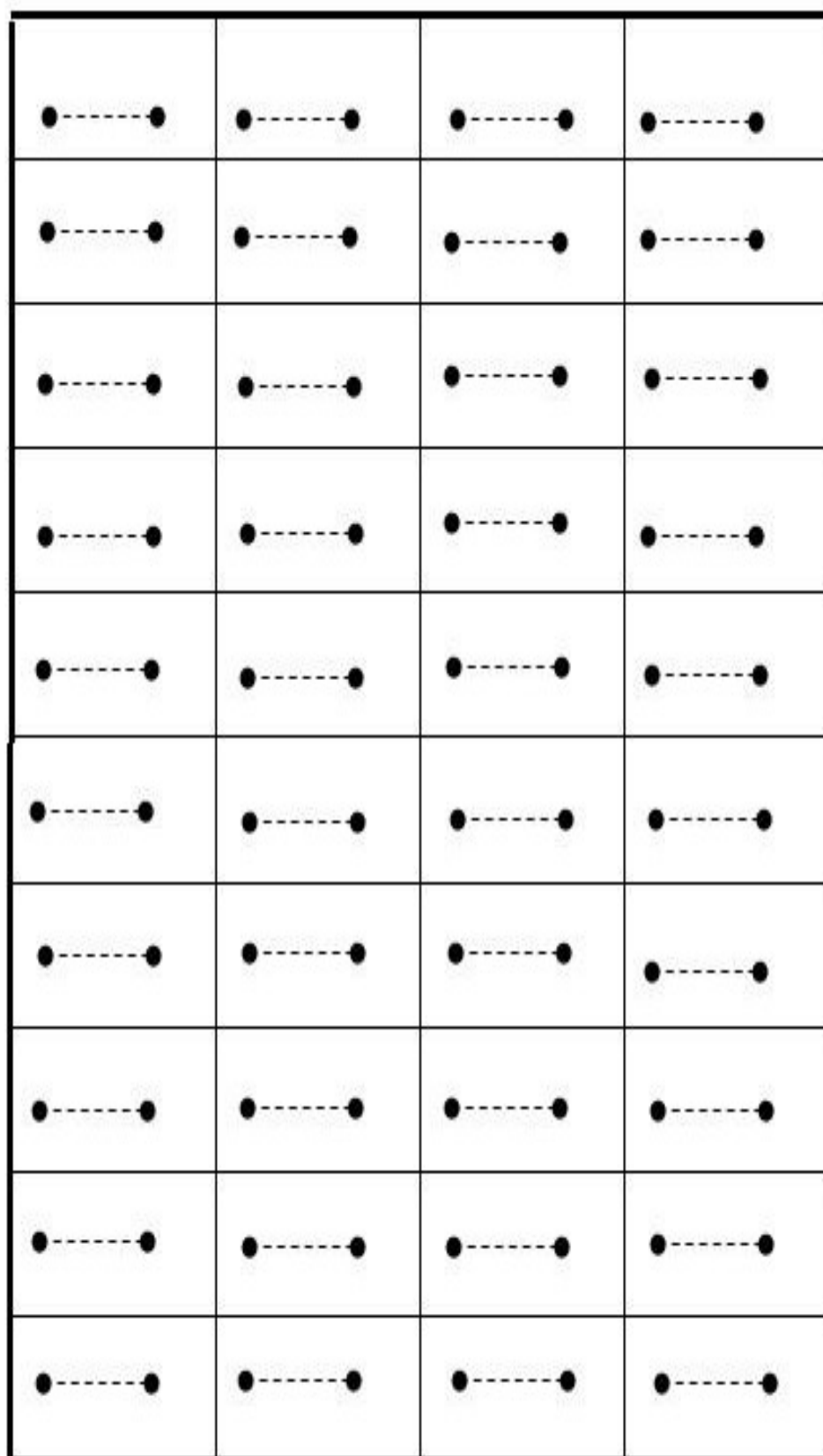

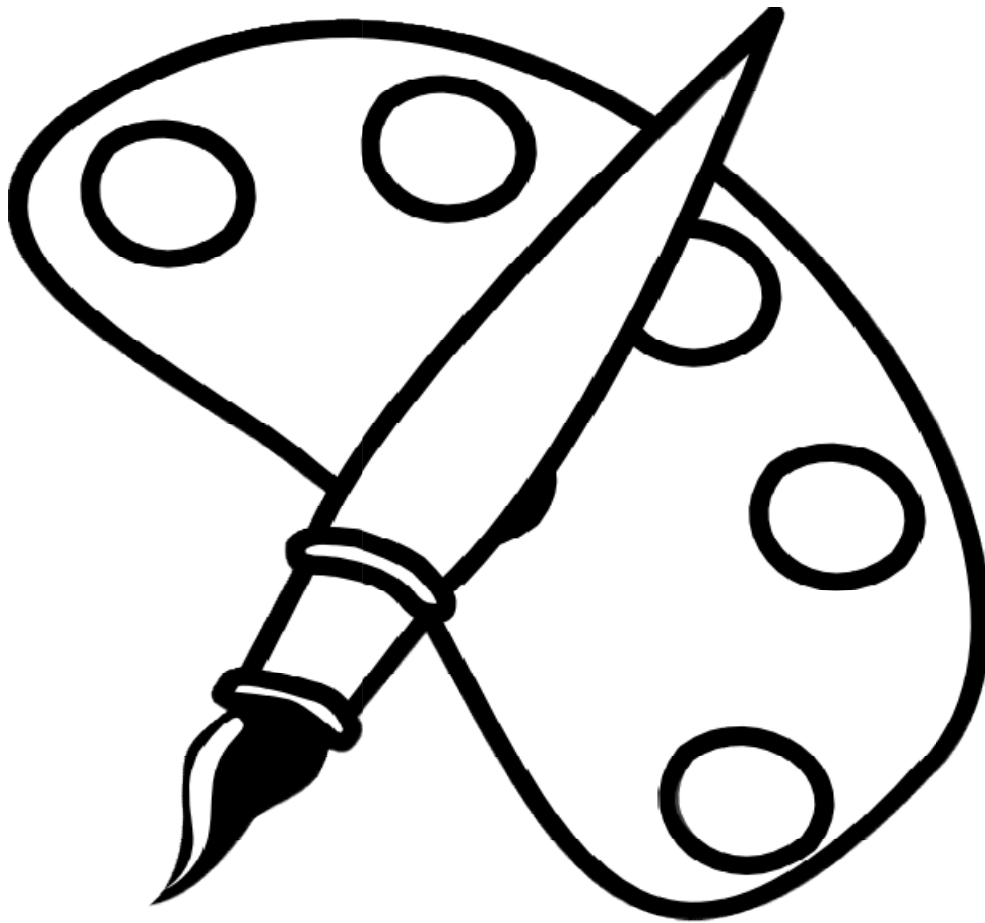

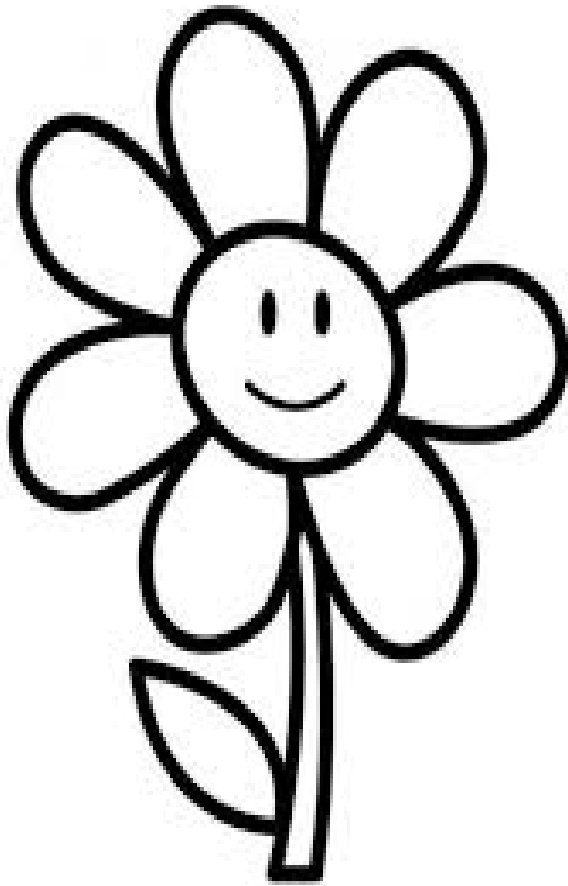


Strawberry, I'm the
best berry.

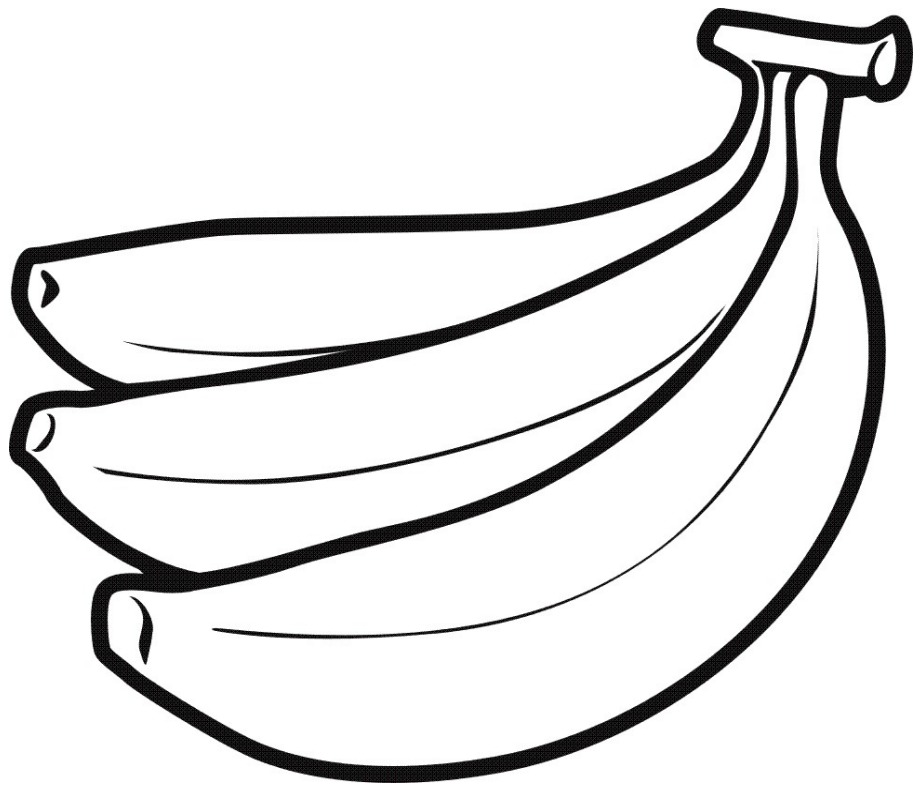


An Apple a day keeps

Colour us Yellow

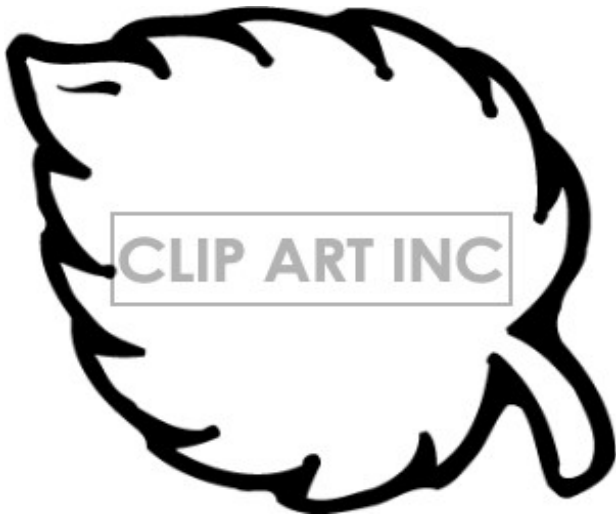


I' m a flower,
beauty of nature!

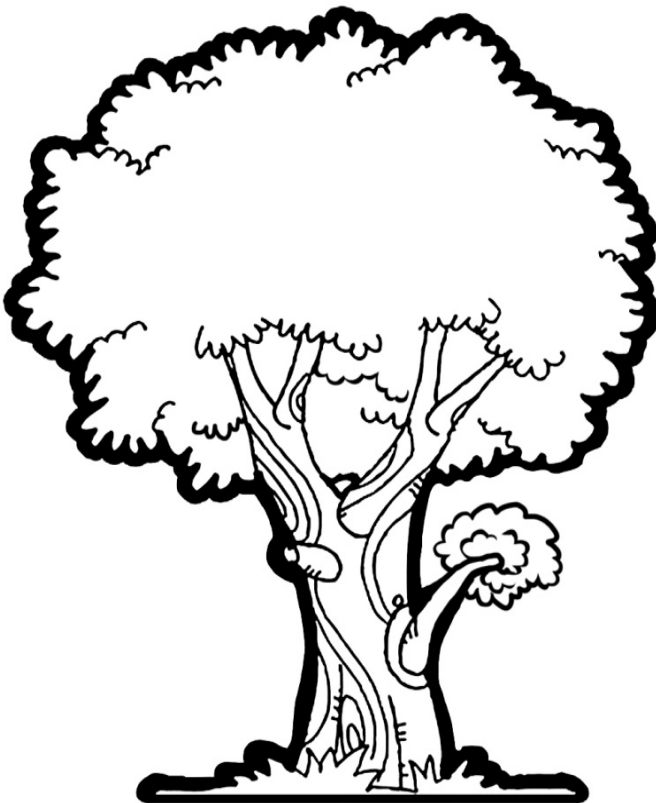


I' m banana,

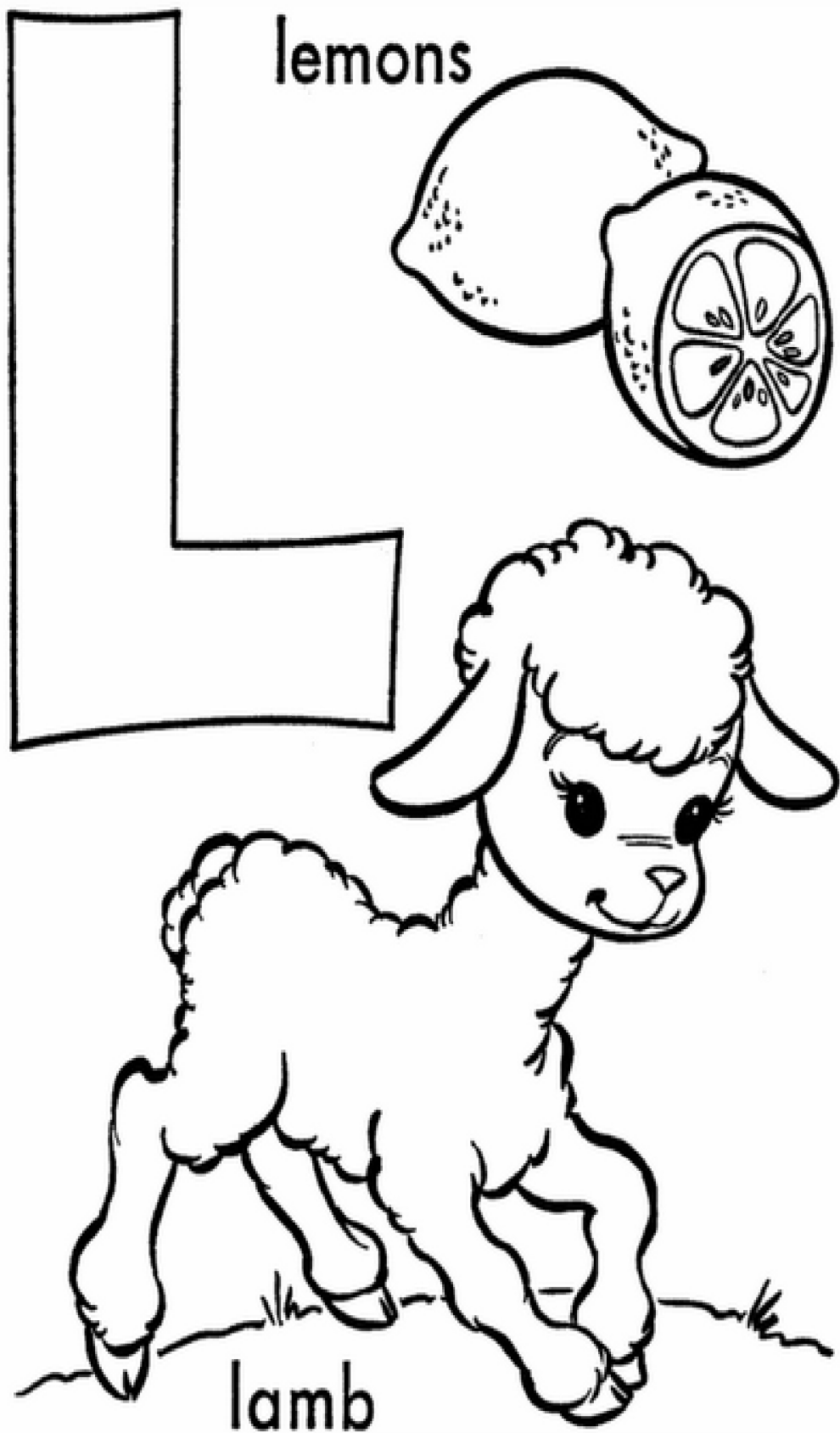


Leaf- I'm the food
